5. Same equipment as used in Presentation must be used in Rider Class.
6. No additions or deletion or leaving the arena between Presentation & Rider Class.
7. All Riders MUST participate in the Mounted presentation.
8. Riders must not leave the grounds until after presentation unless permission given from the CHIEF STEWARD – Julie Lynham
9. Competitors may be asked to produce proof of 2019 PCQ Membership. Horses must be ridden at a walk at all times when not competing. This includes the car park areas.
10. DISPUTES: All complaints should be made to the Chief Steward. Disputes committee will adjudicate accordingly. The complaint must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes & be accompanied by a fee of \$50.
11. By nominating for this Event competitors agree to allow Met. Zone 1 to use any photos taken of them at the Event for promotional purposes on their web
