### The changes for 2020 are:

- Riders 12 and under at official events will compete in their respective age group. It is recommended they enter a horse that they normally ride and compete on.
- Rider 13 & Under 26 years as well as Seniors, may choose their Class for each competition – ie novice one competition / elementary the next.
- For State competitions, a horse/rider combination must compete at the highest qualified level as recorded on their Qualifying card.
- %'s have been changed back to 55% for dressage and 50% for Combined Training.
- As from 2020 there will be no points allocated on Performance cards for placings, just %'s which will be used for State qualifications.

### **DISCLAIMER:**

Neither the Organizing Committee, nor PCAQ, nor Wynnum Pony Club accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any horse, owners, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

**Reservation of Rights** – The Organisers reserve the right:

- (a) to cancel any class or event
- (b) to divide any class
- (c) to alter the advertised times
- (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class
- (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors

**Two Horse Rule** - Riders may enter two horses in the same or different grades/heights. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

**Callers** are not permitted for the Dressage phase of the Combined Training competition with the exception of the Unofficial Class 15.

**Teams** to consist of the best 4 scores from official classes from each Club, with the best 3 scores to count - a team of 3 is acceptable and may beat a team of 4.

Nominations must include each rider's PCAQ Membership Number. Riders competing in Official Classes must hand in their Performance Card prior to the competition commencing.

**Setup** - Clubs are reminded that this is a Zone event and they must supply two workers for the **SETUP OF DRESSAGE ARENAS ON Saturday 7th March prior to the start of the competition**. Workers to nominate online. Failure to attend this working bee will result in the club riders competing HC.

**Competition Days** – Clubs are to supply 1 worker for each 3 riders or part thereof on the day of the competition. Jobs will include but not limited to pencilling, gate and rail stewards and gear check.
