1. 12 years and under	60cm
2. 12 years and under	70cm
3. 12 years and under	80cm
4. 13 years and under 26	70cm
5. 13 years and under 26	80cm
6. 13 years and under 26	90cm
7. 13 years and under 26	100cm
8. 13 years and under 26	110cm
9. 13 years and under 26	120cm

Unofficial Classes \$45 inc \$10 First Aid Levy

10. 12 years and under	50cm
11. 13 years and under 26	60cm
12. Seniors	Choose height from class 1, or 4-9. If not stated will be placed in Class 5. To be eligible for overall award must choose 70cm and above.

TWO HORSE RULE – Riders may enter 2 horses in the same or different heights. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards. For Jumping Equitation, the second horse must be in same group to be competitive.

Mobile Phones: **Riders are not to carry on their person any mobile phone whilst mounted.**

PROTESTS – Must be in writing within 30 minutes of incident, accompanied by \$50. Only the owner, his authorised agent, or the rider of the horse taking part in the competition is entitled to lodge a protest. Disputes committee to consist of PCAQ Technical Delegate, Chief Steward and One Judge.

WORKERS – SETUP – Zone 1 Clubs are reminded that this is a Zone event and they must supply two willing workers for the working bee to be held on Saturday 5th June. Workers to nominate online. Failure to attend this working bee will result in the club riders competing HC.
