Seniors Option A: Seniors to choose from classes D4,5,6,7 or 8 (Official Preliminary, Novice, Elementary, Medium or Preparatory) to be eligible for overall awards, but if no class stated will ride D4 Official Preliminary.

- CT Dressage phase must be completed before jumping phase.
- Only 2 Dressage test to be ridden, the dressage tests in bold will double as your CT test.
- A rider may ride in both Dressage & CT on the one day on the same horse BUT cannot compete across two graded dressage levels e.g. novice dressage and A1 CT.
- Therefore if you ride novice dressage, you will ride novice CT – B2
- NO callers in CT Dressage Official or Seniors Classes.

Two Horse Rule - Riders may enter two horses in the same or different grades/heights. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

Protests: Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and should be accompanied by a \$50 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld.

Canteen: All facilities available on the day.

Nominations must include each rider's PCQ Membership Number. Riders competing in Official Classes must hand in their Performance Card prior to the competition commencing.

Set-up Clubs are reminded that this is a Zone event and if their riders both competitions they must supply two workers for the setup and nominate online.

Competition Days – Clubs are to supply 1 worker for each 3 riders or part thereof on the day of the competition. Jobs will include but not limited to pencilling, gate and rail stewards and gear check pencillers.
